### Enzymes

These biological catalysts accelerate chemical reactions without being consumed in the process Enzymes are highly specific each one typically acting on a single type of substrate

#### Mechanism of Action

Enzymes lower the activation energy of a reaction making it proceed faster They achieve this by providing an alternative reaction pathway with a lower energy barrier

#### Factors Affecting Enzyme Activity

##### Temperature

Enzymes have optimal temperatures at which they function best Too high or too low temperatures can denature the enzyme making it inactive

##### pH

Similar to temperature each enzyme has an optimal pH range Extreme pH values can disrupt the enzymes structure and function

##### Substrate concentration

The rate of an enzymecatalyzed reaction increases with increasing substrate concentration until it reaches a point of saturation where all enzyme active sites are occupied

##### Inhibitors

Substances that reduce enzyme activity Inhibitors can be competitive competing with the substrate for binding to the active site or noncompetitive binding to a different site on the enzyme altering its shape

##### Regulation of Enzyme Activity

#### Allosteric regulation

Involves the binding of a regulatory molecule to a site other than the active site causing a conformational change in the enzyme and affecting its activity

#### Covalent

modification Involves the addition or removal of a chemical group to or from the enzyme altering its activity

3 Energy Flow in Living Systems From Sunlight to Cellular Work Metabolism The sum of all chemical reactions that occur in a living organism Catabolism The breakdown of complex molecules into simpler ones releasing energy Examples include the breakdown of glucose to generate ATP Anabolism The synthesis of complex molecules from simpler ones requiring energy Examples include protein synthesis and DNA replication ATP The Energy Currency Adenosine triphosphate ATP is the primary energy currency of cells The hydrolysis of ATP to ADP adenosine diphosphate releases energy which is used to power cellular processes Cellular Respiration The process by which cells extract energy from glucose ultimately generating ATP Cellular respiration occurs in three main stages Glycolysis The breakdown of glucose into pyruvate occurring in the cytoplasm Krebs cycle Citric Acid Cycle A series of reactions that oxidize pyruvate generating electron carriers NADH and FADH<sub>2</sub> This occurs in the mitochondria Electron Transport Chain A chain of electron carriers embedded in the mitochondrial membrane Electrons are passed down the chain releasing energy used to pump protons across the membrane generating a proton gradient This gradient is then used to drive ATP synthesis via ATP synthase

4 Genetic Code The Blueprint of Life DNA The Information Carrier Deoxyribonucleic acid DNA is the genetic material of most organisms It carries the instructions for building and maintaining an organism Structure of DNA DNA is a double helix with two strands of nucleotides linked together by hydrogen bonds Each nucleotide consists of a sugar deoxyribose a phosphate group and one of four nitrogenous bases adenine A guanine G cytosine C and thymine T Adenine pairs with thymine and guanine pairs with cytosine RNA The Messenger Ribonucleic acid RNA plays a crucial role in protein synthesis There are different types of RNA each with a specific function Messenger RNA mRNA Carries the genetic code from DNA to ribosomes where protein synthesis occurs Transfer RNA tRNA Carries specific amino acids to ribosomes for protein synthesis Ribosomal RNA rRNA Forms part of the ribosome the site of protein synthesis Transcription The process of copying the genetic code from DNA to mRNA Translation The process of converting the genetic code in mRNA into a protein sequence This occurs at the ribosome where tRNA molecules bring specific amino acids according to the mRNA sequence
